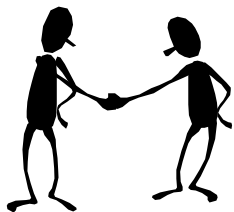
Pennsylvania State PA Promise changes

In January 2013, PA Promise began adding co-pay, co-insurance and deductible data to the EVS data. Print reports with or without the new data.

PA Promise now allows requesting data for the entire month, not just the next working day.

What is Eligibility 5010? A comprehensive batch EVS application providing Client change reports; reports of inactive clients, reports of rejected clients (bad data) and comprehensive reports of the eligibility status of all clients

Major updates of the database and report engines

Run SQL queries directly on the eligibility data. Use client/server access or ODBC. Print, save or email reports as *.pdf *.doc, *.xls)
